Covid - 19 Updates

You may have heard about changes to visiting policies and the easing of some restrictions for long-term care facilities and assisted living that was mentioned in the news. We have not made any changes yet as we are waiting on the official directive from the VCH medical health officer and the Assisted Living Registrar before we change any of our policies.

We will let all tenants and families know of any changes as they occur.

Sign-In / Sign-Out Book

When leaving the building, all tenants are required to sign-out in the book provided at the front door prior to leaving. Upon returning all tenants are required to sign back in and get their temperature taken by someone in our front office.

If you are unable to write in the sign-out book due to poor vision, please ask a staff person to assist you.

Masks
